

Abbey Theater

Located in the heart of downtown Abbeville, the building was first a saloon in 1908 and later the old Reaux Lumber Company. In 1977, the Abby Players first rented the old building and then purchased it, turning it into a first class arena theatre.

Once we arrived we were given a tour by Drew, one of the main actors and board member of the theater. He told us about personal experiences in the theater. Some of these experiences included doors opening and shutting on their own, lights flickering and items that have fallen or moved.

Once the tour was concluded it was time to get to work. We set up our infrared/night vision cameras, rim pods, K2 meters and recorders. Cameras were set up in the theater, in the long hallway, and in the backstage stairs. We had a team of 6, each carrying a digital voice recorder, cameras and K2. We were pleased to have the company of members of the theater join us for the investigation.

EVP's: None were found from investigation.

Video: One of the cameras recorded a strange shadow moving around the stairs in the hallway of the theater.

Picture: A picture was taken without flash of a possible orb between two of the investigators.

Personal: One of the investigators was touched twice on the back at the same time a shadow was seen behind her and a picture was taken of a possible orb between the 2 investigators.

The K2 meter had several hits throughout the night.
