



Investigation Summary Report

Victor's Café New Iberia, LA.



HISTORY

Victor's was originally Pfister's Jewelers of 1897. This beautiful, old building is located on Main Street in old downtown New Iberia. Victor's Cafeteria opened in 1969 and does not seem to have changed much over the years. The interior has striped, wallpapered with framed photographs showing fun times from the past and present. The history of this location, before being a jewelry store or café, goes way back! This whole downtown area was once Shadows on the Teche plantation land and holds Civil War history.

EXPERIENCES

The owners have experienced noises, knocks, bangs in the restaurant when no one was there. Former employees have witnessed utensils being placed on the counter tops after they cleaned the kitchen for the day. There has been a report of a full bodied apparition in the area near the restrooms behind the kitchen.

Equipment used: digital voice recorders, wireless cameras, Rem pods, K 2 Meters, digital still camera, SLS camera, Full Spectrum Camera. Mel Meter, Boo Belle and Spirit box.

We proceeded with our base line sweeps for EMF in all areas. While doing the walkthrough we also took pictures. After the walkthrough we proceeded to set up all equipment in the locations. Many participants had personal experiences. We had Rem Pods go off, door squeaked in hallway (twice), knocks and a very loud bang! Upon hearing the loud bang sound we spread out to find the source. When we entered the kitchen area we discovered an aluminum pan had fallen off a shelf into a bucket. At this point we attempted to recreate the event. After several different ideas and attempts, we could not recreate that pan falling. The owner also informed us that the pan had been on that shelf since February. (video included)

Several team members did Estes Method with the Spirit Box and got responses related to “pan” and “it was me”. One team member stationed in the attic saw what appeared to be a shadow peek out from behind a piece of furniture. Upon asking if anyone saw something by the furniture, the owner’s daughter stated seeing the exact same figure and pointed to the location. One of our investigators was touched on the elbow. Another investigator heard the voice of a woman twice. There were sounds of slamming doors and pots banging in kitchen area.
