



## Investigation Summary Report

Private Residence

West Monroe, LA

### HISTORY

We were called in because a lot of activity has been witnessed in this house from lights flickering, phone's lighting up for no reason, and an apparition has been seen on more than one occasion by more than one person. As an extremely unfortunate event, the family lost their teenage son recently and they strongly feel that it is his presence that still lingers in the home. Whether it be residual or the son letting his family know he is around, we knew this case had the potential to be interesting.

### INVESTIGATION

We arrived on location at 8:00 PM on July 25th 2008. On arrival, we were given a tour of the house and told a brief history of the activity. We began setting up our equipment. We used one DVR setup with 4 infrared cameras. We also used a FLIR thermal camera, various EMF meters, various infrared thermometers, various digital cameras, and various voice recorders which included an H4 and H2. We went lights out around 9:00 PM.

At first we broke into two groups of three. We were in each spot for 30 minutes and then switched. We then called the mom out to see if she could get any responses. We wanted to try something different, so we had a group EVP session. During the investigation, we had several personal experiences. A few investigators actually heard whispering in the bedroom. Another pair of investigators thought they heard humming. One investigator at one point had a dizzy spell and actually stumbled. A few cold spots were also felt in the living room. We finished up around 1:00 AM. It seemed to be an eventful night!

### FINDINGS

After reviewing our evidence, we didn't find anything on video or on the thermal but we did capture a very interesting sound clip which is listed below. In a very emotional bit of evidence, we recorded a faint voice which seems to say, "I'm still here!" This obviously shook up the family, as it seemed to only strengthen their beliefs that the house still contained the presence of their son!
